Volunteering is a wonderful way to meet new people and give back to the community. We have volunteer opportunities in a variety of areas, skilled and unskilled.

Some of the Volunteer jobs available:

Sewing & Crafting

Sew or make banners or favors. This is a pre-faire task.

Poster Hanging

We are in great need of more volunteers to hang posters or hand out flyers in Placer and Nevada counties in the weeks prior to the faire. Volunteers from Citrus Heights, Roseville, Rocklin, Lincoln, Loomis, Penryn, Newcastle, Ophir, Cool, Applegate, Weimar, Colfax, Foresthill, Grass Valley and Nevada City are especially needed.

Set-up/ Teardown

Many hands make light work. Many jobs to fill – assemble structures or fences, hang burlap or signs, move wood or hay bales, etc. Positions start Friday before the faire and include post-faire time on Sunday and Monday.

Parking

Direct participants and visitors to designated parking areas.

Volunteer Registration

Sign-in volunteers and guide them where to go.

Children's Glen

Assist in entertaining the kids. Activities include games, arts, crafts, songs, etc. This is not childcare, parents must be present.

Sponsor Acquisition

We are in great need of more sponsors. Talk to local businesses and individuals about donating dollars, services or product to the faire. We will provide a sponsor packet to hand out to potential sponsors.
